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Standard Changes/Updates/Recalls FSSC 22000 Version 5.1



In November of 2020, FSSC 22000 published Version 5.1. All Scheme Documents can be downloaded for free at: www.fssc22000.com/scheme/sheme-documents-version-5-1/

Key changes from Version 5 to Version 5.1

- 15 additional requirements (11 of which is for Packaging and Manufacturing Facilities)
- Management of Services changed to Management of Services and Purchased Material
- Competent Laboratory (internal or external)
- Product Labeling (Customer Requirements and Food Allergens)
- Storage and Warehouse
- Food Defense, Food Fraud
- Logo Use
- Environmental Monitoring
- Hazard Control and Measures for Preventing Cross Contamination
- PRP Verification and GMP Check
- Product Development

This affects all levels within Food Manufacturing, Processing, Catering, Retailing and other Food Businesses responsible for the development of a Food Safety Management System including:

- Food safety Managers, Food Safety Team members, Technical Managers, Quality Assurance Managers, Quality Control Managers, Production Managers, Purchasing Managers, Plant Workshop Managers, Warehousing Managers,
- Transport/Logistics Managers & Stores Manager, Laboratory Managers, Laboratory Team Leaders and Supervisors
- Food Safety Auditors and Factory Inspectors and Supervisors
